So in September we will start this work, challenging people to get involved themselves in being a part of unreached people groups hearing the Gospel for the first time. It's a sad fact that there are millions of people who have yet to hear the name of Jesus for the first time. Therefore we feel that it would be great to spend a year encouraging others to pray, give and go.

We have finally completed the Jungle Camp module!! We were part of a team learning a Burmese tribal language called Dai (sounds Welsh doesn't it!). Our language helper was called Shwikee from Burma (see photo below). The task was to learn as much as possible of the language and culture of the Dai people in five weeks. At the end of this time, our learned language was put to the test during an ethnic meal where we could only converse in Dai. Jungle Camp however, was not just language learning. There were great times of fellowship in the mornings and volleyball in the evenings. As part of the module we were required to bake bread in the clay ovens, do a tent census and a map of the immediate area. We had to simulate living in a tribe as much as possible, so we were not allowed back onto the campus during this time. Before the camp we had to buy everything we would need for five weeks with a supply run once a week for fresh food only. Our fridge was a container in a hole in the ground and we had to collect our water every day. Toilets and showers were very basic but hygienic! We had a great time.
